- Entries for geography A-level have decreased for boys and girls down by 873 from 2010 to 2011
- These changes have had little effect on the gender balance of entries taking geography with only a 1% change up for girls and a corresponding 1% fall for boys (53% Males / 47% Females)
- Percentage obtaining an A* grade has increased for both boys and girls. Females performed much better (9.0%) against 5.5% of Males. Overall percentage 7.1% compared to 8.3% for all subjects
- As a proportion of the total entry for A-levels geography is holding its own – again no change this year.
- Geography retains its 10th position in entries for A-levels
- 85% of those who sat AS level in 2010 continued to do A-level. This is relatively similar to the past few years
- History increased A-level entry by 1675

- 14th largest increase in subject numbers
- Again proportions of entries stay roughly the same 54% males 46% females
- % obtaining A grades at AS has decreased by 0.7%. Females perform better than males. Performance gap is 9.6%) Males (19.3% - Females 28.9%) Average figure for A grade for all subjects (males and Females) is 19.3%
- Geography in 13th position in entries for AS levels
- Overall increase in all subject entries – up by 214429
- History entries increased by 12421

The overall pass rate rose for the 29th successive year to hit 97.8 percent, while around one in 12 exams achieved the top A* grade. There was a 7.4 percent rise in the numbers sitting a maths A-level and broadly similar increases across the sciences. Modern languages including Spanish, French and German all saw declines.
