

Honorary Vice-President Peter Jackson



Peter Jackson is Professor of Human Geography at the University of Sheffield where he teaches social and cultural geography. His research focuses on geographies of consumption, with a particular interest in food. He is currently leading an ERA-Net project on food, convenience and sustainability with colleagues in Denmark, Germany and Sweden, and an ESRC project on the enactment of freshness in the UK and Portuguese agri-food sectors. Peter was Head of the Department of Geography (2000-3) and Director of Research for the Faculty of Social Sciences at the University of Sheffield (2004-7). He has also served as Chair of the Food Standards Agency's Social Science Research Committee and on the Editorial Collective of *Geography* (2008-15). Recent publications include *Food Words* (2013) and

Anxious Appetites (2015), both published by Bloomsbury.
