COMMENTS INCLUDED WITH RETURNS

- Tutors from Edge Hill; Middlesex; UEA; Sussex; Brighton mentioned that they had been contacted by schools seeking geography teachers after all their students had gained posts.
- Some who were under-target i.e. Leicester, Canterbury, Middlesex, Marjons, Bristol pointed out this was due to late drop-outs, too late to replace, and should not be interpreted as under-recruitment.
- Leicester stated that the TDA allows a redistribution of numbers across non-shortage subjects. Two geography places were 'lost' to history due to late drop-outs (see bullet above) although there was then a late flood of applications which meant that the geography course could have recruited to target.
- Portsmouth, Sussex and Brighton all point out that they could recruit more good candidates if they had higher allocations. Brighton and Sussex also reported lots of requests for teachers after the previous cohort had all gained jobs (see first bullet).
- Several tutors mentioned a strong field and buoyant recruitment.
- Middlesex, Hull & Soton reported that last year's trainees were snapped up very quickly with most being appointed at the first interview.
