Detached housing comes out strongly as the housing type they aspire to.

12 out of 14 thought that it was better to buy

Maybe worth exploring where this comes from. Do their parents tell them that it is better to buy than rent? Are all their parents currently owner occupiers?

8 out of 14 thought that they would be able to afford to buy

Again this may be worth exploring further. Why do those who disagree think they will not be able to afford to buy? Most of them say that they think they will go on to university so they must be thinking that they will get a 'decent' job. How much does the media influence their views on this?

9 out of 14 thought that at some time they would move out of East Lancashire to study. All thought that they would have to do this because they want to go to university.

Only 4 thought that they would work in East Lancashire. The 6 who responded that they didn't think they would didn't have a reason for this.

Could we tease out of them the reasons why?
