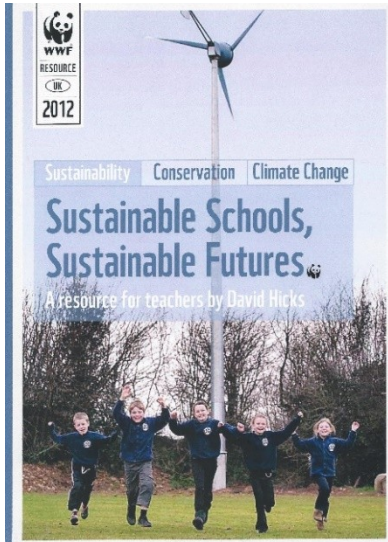


# SUSTAINABLE SCHOOLS, SUSTAINABLE FUTURES
