

Geographical Association Physical Geography Student Photo Competition

Terms & Conditions

Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.

The Geographical Association (GA) Physical Geography Student Photo Competition is open to school pupils in years 7–13 during the academic year 2022–23 who are residents of the UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man or who attend an accredited British school overseas. There are two categories:

- Years 7–9
All entries to this category must include a signed parental consent form. Entries without this form will not be considered.
- Years 10–13

Entries must be submitted using the website <https://geography.org.uk/Physical-geography-student-photo-competition/> before the closing date of 30 September 2023.

All photos submitted must be the work of the person submitting them. Entrants must warrant that the photo they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it.

Copyright of all images submitted for this competition remains with the respective entrants. However, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to the GA, Geographical Association Physical Geography Special Interest Group (GA PGSIG) and British Society for Geomorphology (BSG) to feature any or all of the submitted images in any of their publications, their websites and/or in any promotional material connected to this competition.

Only one entry is permitted per person. Late or corrupt entries will not be accepted.

The winning entries will be those judged on their visual appeal and quality of the photo, and the quality of the accompanying description with a particular emphasis on the physical geography contained therein. The decision of the judges is final.

Prizes are courtesy of our sponsor, the British Society for Geomorphology and will be outdoor clothing from Paramo Directional Clothing Systems. The details are noted on the GA website. All prizes are non-transferable and there are no cash alternatives.

All winners and entries judged as Highly Commended will receive a copy of the Collins Student Atlas from the GA and a certificate.

The winners may be invited to take part in publicity events.

Events may occur that render the competition itself or the awarding of the prizes impossible due to reasons beyond the control of the GA and accordingly the GA may at their absolute discretion vary or amend the promotion. The entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the GA as a result thereof.
