

# WHAT'S THE ISSUE?

## DEVELOPING ANSWERS

Teachers would be advised to remind candidates, that to get full marks they should build their answers by giving a reason and elaborating, then giving another reason and elaborating.

“Candidates that did discuss a limitation of one of these methods were unable to develop their limitation further to ‘explain’ why this was a limitation. This was a matter of exam technique and candidates understanding the expectations of an ‘explain’ question.”

Candidates that did identify an improvement made comments around the use of improved equipment, like a flow meter for measuring velocity, but were frequently held at 1 mark because there was limited development as to why this would improve the method.”
